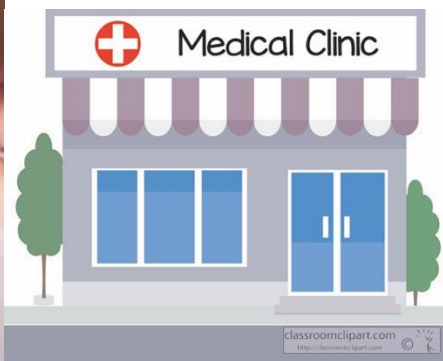

## How to help your child improve reading?

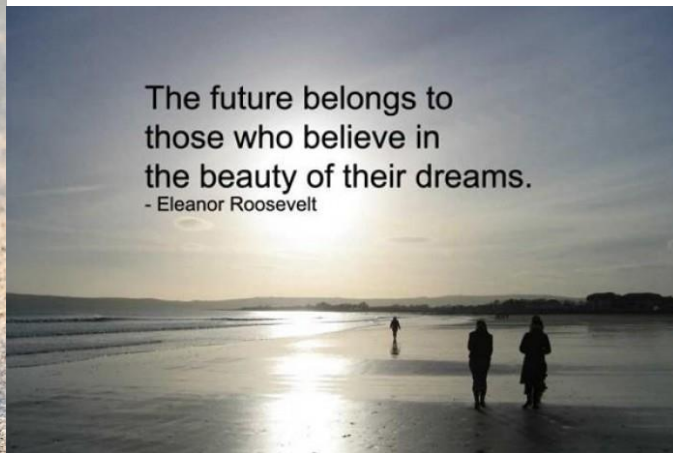
